Annice Sadman being duly sworn on her oath, says that she is the* widow of Anton Sadman deceased, late of the county of Callaway county, who died on or about the 24 day of February 1882, and that the estate of said deceased does not exceed the sum of Twenty

DOLLARS in value, consisting of:

FIRST. A Family Bible and other books of the value of None DOLLARS.

SECOND. Household, kitchen and table furniture, including beds, bedsteads and bedding of the value of Twenty DOLLARS.

THIRD. Provisions of the value of Twenty DOLLARS.

FOURTH. Other personal property, consisting of Two Coats
and an Apron

amounting in the aggregate to the sum of Forty DOLLARS.

That the family of said decedent consisted of Annice Sadman widow
official decedent and that in addition to the provisions on hand and provided at the time of the death of said decedent, there will be needed for the subsistence of said family, for twelve months, the sum of Twenty Five Dollars in lieu of provisions not so on hand.

Said affiant further states that said deceased had no property or effects of any kind whatsoever, at the time of his death, except the property above mentioned, as far as she has been able to ascertain.

Wherefore she pray^s the Court to Order that no Letters of Administration be issued on said estate, unless on the application of creditors or other parties interested, the existence of other or further property be shown.
